Programme Overview

This apprenticeship is designed for learners who want to become a JNC qualified Youth Support Worker and develop their skills in leading work with young people.

On completion of this apprenticeship, learners will meet the minimum requirement to work as a Joint Negotiating Committee (JNC) qualified Youth Support Worker.

Our blended learning approach gives learners support in the workplace alongside online learning. Learners are provided with their own digital learning plan where they can access learning resources, develop their ePortfolio, and see real-time updates on their progress.

Who the programme is suitable for

Learners over the age of 16 who deliver operational youth work and undertake duties on their own initiative or have supervisory responsibility for small projects.
